### **Program Requirements**

#### **Program Eligibility:**

Ages 5-12 (Must be potty-trained)

Participants will participate in variety of activities provided by YMCA staff

#### **Hours:**

6 a.m. – 5 p.m. (Hours may vary based on need of 1<sup>st</sup> shift hospital personnel (i.e. 7a-7p shifts))

#### **Pricing:**

\$35 day/\$165 week \*

\*Partial scholarships or subsidies may be available, check with local branch for details;

\*UC Health will pay for/be billed for 50% of the cost

#### **Registration:**

Contact your local YMCA that is offering this program option. Space is limited, registration will be first come, first serve. Proof of employment must be provided upon first check-in.
